Definition of hazard types:


- 1. **Lip:** lip protruding for several feet at least 1 inch above adjacent pavement
- **2. Gap:** gap extending for several feet, in which bike tire could fall into
- 3. Pothole: hole that should be filled
- 4. Rough area: excessively rough area the should be fixed
- **5. Maintenance:** not a danger to cyclists but something the county might want to be aware of
- **6. Other:** items that don't fall into the above

Severity ratings


- Level 4 A serious and immediate danger to cyclists
- Level 3 Should be fixed soon; could be a danger
- Level 2 Potential hazard to note, but not very serious

 Level 1 - Not hazard to cyclists, but something that the county might want to be aware of

Severity: 2

6" wide gouge in the shoulder over 4 feet long which cyclists tire could get stuck in and cause bike to fall. Unlike Flintridge, Shoulder is wider on this stretch of and cyclists are able to ride to the right of the damaged shoulder comfortably if they see the pot hole in time.


